Do you know that **25 March is Waffle Day** in Sweden?

The name of this Swedish tradition is actually a misunderstanding. It originated from a Christian celebration, "Vårfrudagen" ("Our Lady's Day"), which sounds like "Våffeldagen" ("Waffle Day"), in Swedish. From then, it became a tradition to eat waffles on this day every year!

Waffles come in all shapes and sizes – and flavours! Let's take a look at the some of the different waffles from around the world.



The **Swedish waffle (Våfflor)** is often eaten on Waffle Day to celebrate the beginning of spring. They are made in a heart-shaped waffle iron. The waffles are usually topped with jam and whipped cream. Yum!

Waffles from Brussels

Belgian waffles are light, crispy and have deep pockets. It is dusted with sugar. Other toppings for the waffles include whipped cream, soft fruit or chocolate spread.


Waffles from Hong Kong





Have some leftovers from last night's dinner or veggies that are a little old? These yummy breakfast muffins are a great way to use them up! This recipe makes 6 muffins.

6 large eggs 60ml milk

Chicken slices

Mushroom

Tomatoes

Cheese

Salt and pepper



- light and fluffy.
- Stir in ham, mushroom and tomatoes into the egg mixture. (Tip: Get creative and add in whatever ingredients you have. The possibilities are endless!)
- Season the egg mixture with a pinch of salt and pepper. Mix well.
- Pour the egg mixture into 6 muffin tins then place the cheese on top. Afterwards, get mum or dad to help you put it in the oven.
- Bake for about 25-30 minutes or until the eggs has set. (Tip: To check if the eggs have set, poke a toothpick into the muffin. If it comes out clean, it's ready to be taken out!)
- After the muffins are done baking, get mum or dad to help you take it out of the oven. Let the muffins cool slightly before serving them.


